- All quilts must have a 4" sleeve on the back to hang your quilt. If your quilt is over 90" long, please place your sleeve at 90" from the bottom in order to keep it off the floor. Miniatures may use smaller rod pockets of only 2".
- There is a limit of 2 entries per category or a total of 3 items per person (donated auction quilts are not included in the totals).
- Non-members of the Guild pay a non-refundable entry fee of \$10.00 per entry.
- All quilts must have been completed after July 1, 2005 to be judged and must be clean and in good condition.
- No return entries unless you have an invitation.
- All quilts entered must have the top completed at the time of entry. (We are serious about that photo!) We strongly discourage the withdrawal of entries from the show. If you cannot be absolutely certain that your entry will be complete when entries are to be delivered, please **DO NOT ENTER IT!** You may keep someone else from being able to enter their finished quilt.
- All quilts must have a label sewn (baste if needed) to the quilt back showing your name, address and telephone number. For convenience and consistency, we prefer the lower left hand corner of the back. Quilt must be submitted in a cloth bag with a label including the entrant's contact information. One entry per bag.
- **MAKE SURE YOUR NAME APPEARS ON THIS PAGE ONLY, NOT ON PAGE 2.**
- The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to change the skill level or category of any entry we deem inappropriate.

**INSURANCE POLICY:** Entrants are responsible for insuring their own entries. The executive committee, chairpersons, Creative Quilters Guild of Ellis County, or the Midlothian Conference Center can not be held responsible for loss or damage to your entry.

**HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT:** To the maximum extent permitted by law, attendance and participation in any Quilt Show by Creative Quilters Guild of Ellis County events (paid or not) constitutes your agreement to hereby indemnify Midlothian Conference Center, The Creative Quilters Guild of Ellis County, its representatives, agents, employees, volunteers and contractors. ## ENTRY DIVISIONS AND CATEGORIES

- \* A Division/Category must be indicated on the Entry form.
- \* The Entries Committee, in conjunction with the Judges and Awards Committee, reserves the right to determine final placement of quilts in categories and to combine or divide categories in order to facilitate judging.
- \* Divisions are determined by the eligibility of the "maker" of the quilt. QGD defines the "maker" as the person who made the quilt top.

### Master Division

If ANY of the following statements are true, you must enter under the "Master" division:

- \* You are a quilter or maker of wearable art and you sell/have sold your work.
- \* You teach/have taught quilting or wearable art techniques.
- \* You have had a quilt compete in the Master Division of the Ellis County Quilt Show in the past.
- \* You have published a quilt or wearable art book or pattern.
- \* You have won a total of two or more blue ribbons in any combination of the following: Ellis County Quilt Show, county, state, national or international quilting.

### Artisan Division

If ALL of the following statements are true, you may enter under the "Artisan" division:

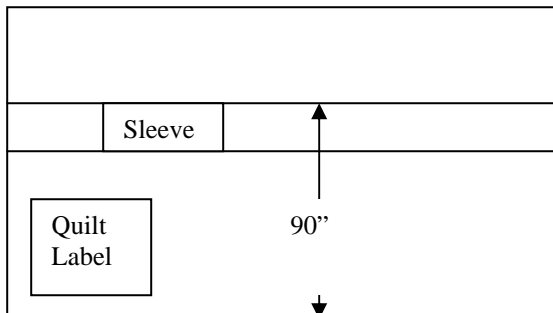
- \* You have never sold your work. (Quilts or wearable are)
- \* You have never formally taught quilting or wearable art techniques.
- \* You have never been classified as a "Master" in the past.
- \* You have never published a pattern or a book on quilting/wearable art techniques.
- \* You have won no more than one blue ribbon in any combination of the following: Ellis County Quilt Show, state, national, or international quilting competitions.

## How to Attach a Hanging Sleeve to Your Quilt

All quilts entered into the show must have a 4" diameter-hanging sleeve running the entire width of the quilt. Miniature quilts are excluded from this requirement. Quilts that are longer than 90" must have the top of the sleeve attached 90" from the bottom of the quilt.

The sleeve should be sewn firmly to your quilt (not pinned) as this is the quilt's only support while hanging during the two-day show.

To construct a sleeve: Cut a strip of fabric at least  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " wide and the length equaling the width of the quilt. Make a narrow hem at each end of the strip. Align the long edges wrong sides together and sew, making a fabric tube. Stitch the top and bottom edges of the tube down making sure that the top edge of the tube measures 90" from the bottom of the quilt.



If you have not already attached a quilt label, please secure it to the bottom left corner.
