CQGEC ~ Divisions & Categories

~ A Division/Category **must** be indicated on the Entry Form.

~ The Entries Committee, in conjunction with the Judges and Awards Committee, reserves the right to determine final placement of quilts in categories and to combine or divide categories in order to facilitate judging.

~ Divisions are determined by the eligibility of the "maker" of the quilt. CQGEC defines the "creator" as the person who made the quilt top.

Master Division - *If ANY of the following statements are true; you must enter under the "Master" division:*

~ You are a quilter or maker of wearable art and you sell/have sold your work.

~ You teach/have taught quilting or wearable art techniques.

~ You have had a quilt compete in the Master Division of any quilt show in the past.

~ You have published a quilt or wearable art book or pattern.

~ You have won a total of two or more blue ribbons in any combination of the following: CQGEC, county, state, national or international quilting competitions.

~ You have had a quilt or garment juried into a highly prestigious exhibit (Ex: The Houston Quilt Show, Quilt National, etc.).

101 Large Pieced - One Person

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72" on any one side and primarily patchwork; either hand or machine quilted.

102 Large Appliqué - One Person

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72" on any one side and primarily appliqué, either hand or machine quilted.

103 Small Quilts - One Person

No side may EXCEED 72". May be pieced, appliqué or combination; hand or machine quilted.

104 Small Quilts - Two-Persons

No side may EXCEED 72" and two people were involved in the making. May be pieced or appliqué; hand or machine quilted.

105 Large Quilts - Two-Persons

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72" on any one side and two people were involved in the making. May be pieced or appliqué; hand or machine quilted.

106 Art Quilts - Open

Original design; any technique or combination of techniques or materials used in a non-traditional way.

Artisan Division - *If ALL of the following statements are true, you may enter under the "Artisan" division:*

~ You have never sold your work (quilts or wearable art).

~ You have never formally taught quilting or wearable art techniques.

~ You have never been classified as a "Master" in the past at any show.

~ You have never published a pattern or a book on quilting/wearable art techniques.

~ You have won no more than one blue ribbon in any combination of the following: CQGEC, county, state, national or international quilting competitions.

~ You have never had a quilt or garment juried into a highly prestigious exhibit (Ex: Quilt National, The Houston Quilt Show, etc.).

201 Large Pieced - One Person

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72" on any one side and primarily patchwork; either hand or machine quilted.

202 Large Appliqué - One Person

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72" on any one side and primarily appliqué, either hand or machine quilted.

203 Small Quilts - One Person

No side may EXCEED 72". May be pieced, appliqué or combination; hand or machine quilted.

204 Small Quilts - Two-Persons

No side may EXCEED 72" and two people were involved in the making. May be pieced or appliqué; hand or machine quilted.

205 Large Quilts - Two-Persons

Any quilt which is LARGER THAN 72" on any one side and two people were involved in the making. May be pieced or appliqué; hand or machine quilted.

206 Art Quilts - Open

Original design; any technique or combination of techniques or materials used in a non-traditional way.

207 First Quilt - One Person

First quilt entered in a judged quilt show.

Open Division - *Master or Artisan*

301 Miniature Quilts - One or Two Persons

Any quilt which has no side measuring more than 24". Any technique may be used. If interior blocks are part of the design, these blocks must measure 4" or less.

302 Mixed Techniques - One or Two Persons

Contains piecing and appliqué, of equal amounts, in one quilt. May be hand or machine quilted.

303 Other Techniques - One or Two Persons

White work, Embroidered, Cathedral Window, Yo-Yo, Crazy Quilts or any other quilt that doesn't fit into the pieced, appliqué or art quilt categories. May be hand or machine quilted.

304 Group/Friendship

Is made by a group of three or more persons using any technique.

305 Show Theme: "Two for the Show"

Two color quilts. Must have only two colors in the quilt. May be pieced or appliqué. May be hand or machine quilted.

306 Garment (one or more persons)

Must be able to be hung for display.

Non-Judged Categories

401 Displayed:*

These quilts may utilize any piecing, appliqué or quilting method, may be an individual or group effort, and can be any size.

* ARE EXEMPT FROM ENTRY FEES.

All Entrants

You may only enter three quilts total, with two per category.

Non-members must pay \$10.00 per quilt. Each quilt must be in a separate cloth bag with entrants name on it, and have its own entry form.
