

# A Tribute to the Troops Mini Memory Quilt Workshop

We will be having a workshop to make the Memory Quilts for some of the Soldiers stationed in Afghanistan on Saturday, May 8th from 9:30 AM till ? We will be meeting at the 1890 House at 398 Broad St. in Cedar Hill. Lori Shelton, who founded this program, will be meeting with us.

We have some materials needed and will try to have some cut and ready to start on. You will need to bring your sewing machine and thread (beige, royal or navy, red, white), and the usual sewing kit tools.

If you have red or blue fabric that would be suitable for the patriotic quilts, patriotic fabrics, light color fabrics (that "read" solid because this is where they write on the quilt), fusible web, or light weight batting you would like to donate, please bring it. What we don't use for these quilts we will use for others to be made later. We can also donate it to Lori for future quilts in her on-going project. She can also use the following:

- scraps of grey (eagle's head)
- gold (eagles beak),
- blue with white stars (top of shield)
- brown (eagle's wings)
- red & white stripe (bottom of shield)

She is drawing and fusing this for us before she gets here so we can help her out by donating our usable scraps and fabrics.
